As many of you will have seen in today's LEP, Preston North End FC has now got in on the act with the plan for a football training academy on the back nine of the course. All of this to be funded by houses on the West side of the golf course. Details are on the next page.

At the moment, the planning consultant for PNE, PWA Planning have only submitted a "Scoping Report", which is a requirement if a planning application requiring an Environmental Impact Assessment is required.

Fortunately, this new requirement now gives us the heads up for an impending planning application, which we expect before the end of the year.
